STRATEGIES TO RECOGNISE POSITIVE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

At Copacabana Public School students are encouraged to become responsible members of the learning community and they are rewarded by:

COPA blues	Students are rewarded for following specific good behaviour tasks with COPA blues which are traded in for various rewards (refer to flowchart)
Wall of Fame	All students are issued with their Wall of Fame, on which they place dots and stickers that recognise participation in school events, good behaviour choices and manners. Students are given gold, silver and bronze medals for sensible behaviour choices in line with RISC at the end of each term.
House Points 3-6	Appropriate social behaviours are recognised by class teachers verbally, with stickers and house points.
Badges K-2	Students who are awarded a Badge for a week will have special privileges for the week such as first to the canteen, sports shed and being special helpers in their respective class.
K-6 Assemblies	Merit certificates are awarded each week to students for personal achievements.
Presentation Day	Students have the opportunity to receive Awards, Certificates, Trophies and Sporting Ribbons at the Annual Presentation Day Ceremony.
Win Bins	Students earn Win Bin tickets for exemplary behaviour from Prefects during assemblies. Students may also receive Scripture Awards from their Scripture teachers. Each week two names are drawn from the Win Bin barrel and those two students receive a lucky dip prize.
Happy Birthday Certificate K-2	Each child in K-2 receives a personalised Happy Birthday Certificate at K-6 Assembly.
Kindergarten Achievement Awards	All students in Kindergarten receive a Certificate of Achievement at the Annual Presentation Day Ceremony.
Home Reading Awards	Children receive recognition awards as they read an increasing number of home readers.
Graduation Certificate	All Year 6 students receive a Graduation Certificate and a gift at the Annual Presentation Day Ceremony.
Citizenship	Citizenship Awards are presented at the Presentation Day Ceremony.
Newsletter and Noticeboard	Student achievement is celebrated through the fortnightly newsletter, school noticeboard and website.
